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	<p>Celina City School District Shall bonds be issued by the Celina City School District for the purpose of paying the School District's portion of the basic project cost under the State of Ohio's Classroom Facilities Assistance Program and locally funded initiatives not exceeding one-half of the School District's portion of the basic project cost (including Celina Intermediate School renovation and addition for grades PK-6; construction of a new 7-12 school building, and the abatement and demolition of the Celina Primary School, Elementary School, Middle School, High School and Education Complex), including technology and site improvements, together with equipment, furnishings, landscaping and all necessary appurtenances thereto, in the principal amount of \$75,982,676 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of thirty-seven (37) years, and an annual levy of property taxes outside the ten mill limitation, estimated by the County Auditor to average over the bond repayment period seven and seven-tenths (7.7) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to seventy-seven cents (\$0.77) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds? and Shall an additional levy of taxes be made for a period of twenty-three years to benefit the Celina City School District, the proceeds of which shall be used to pay the costs of maintaining the classroom facilities included in the project at the rate of one-half (0.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation? 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**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER FOR INDICATING YOUR CHOICES ON A
FEDERAL WRITE-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT (FWAB):**

To complete a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB), go to www.fvap.gov. You have the option of downloading a blank, hard copy FWAB to complete by hand, or proceeding through electronic completion of the FWAB using the website's FWAB Wizard.

The first page of the FWAB is a Voter Declaration/Affirmation you must complete in order for your ballot to count.

After completing the Voter Declaration/Affirmation, use the initial election notice issued on the 100th day before the election and the updated election notice issued on the 45th day before the election as a guide to:

- (1) write the name of each candidate or issue contest for which you are casting a vote and then
- (2) write the name of your choice of candidate or choice for or against an issue.

After you have completed the FWAB, **you must PRINT the ballot and MAIL it to your county board of elections at this address: Mercer County Board of Elections, 101 N. Do not send your ballot via e-mail or fax; Ohio law prohibits electronic transmission of a voted ballot.
